In the mid-20th century, Finn Juhl had a productive collaboration with the furniture manufacturer Søren Willadsen, who ran a cabinetmaker's workshop in the city of Vejen, Denmark. The Willadsen Chair is characterised by its semi-oval gap that allows the backrest to arch freely above the seat. The Willadsen Chair is upholstered by hand in Denmark and is available in textile. The legs are available in FSC® certified oak and American walnut.
