The Wall Sofa Aubertin

In 1951, Finn Juhl designed an extra-long version of his asymmetrical and sculptural Wall Sofa for a private villa for the timber merchant W. F. Aubertin. The organically shaped wall sofa demonstrates both Finn Juhl's fascination with modern abstract art and his desire to defy gravity and create a sense of movement in his designs. The sofa is upholstered by hand in Denmark. The painted frame in a powder coated steel tube is mounted to the wall, hence the name of the sofa.
